GUIDELINES FOR WORKERS AT CAMP ABACO

1. A worker must remember that he/she is *here to minister to the campers* and not to have a vacation.
2. Workers are required to *remain on the grounds*. Under exceptional circumstances, permission may be obtained from the Camp Director.
3. Some Counselors should *eat their meals ahead of Campers* so as to be on grounds when Campers return from their meals.
4. Counselors must have morning and evening devotions (reading a scripture and prayer) with their Campers in the cabins.
5. Camp is *not a dating service* for single counselors and work crews.
6. All workers must *set an example* above reproach to the campers.
7. Discipline must be administered to Campers *in love*.
8. All workers with few exceptions should *make themselves readily available to the Campers* at all times.
9. Do not verbally cut down any facet of the Camp: especially in the presence of Campers. *Take all complaints to the Camp Director or Camp Coordinator.*
10. Workers may enter the kitchen at the discretion of the kitchen staff.
11. Report all sickness to the Camp Nurse.
12. *Workers should be at Chapel services.* Let us set an example for the Campers!
13. No special favours, unless in case of sickness, is to be given to anyone.
14. Either the Counselor or Assistant must be in with the Campers at Lights Out and remain there. Suggestion: *take shifts.*
15. No practical jokes that will cause harm, property damage, or undue embarrassment. They are not so practical.
16. Workers with small babies and young children will need to make arrangements for someone to look after them while you are away at Camp. Your children (unless they are camping) will not be allowed to accompany you to Camp as they would hinder you in carrying out your duties at Camp.
